

## Australian Mathematics Competition 2023

Dear Parent/Guardian,

The Australian Mathematics Competition (AMC) is an engaging 30-problem competition that demonstrates the importance and relevance of mathematics in students' everyday lives; it is open to students in Years 3 to 12. Australia's leading educators and academics, with a deep understanding of our national curriculum standards, actively design the unique AMC problems each year.

Held between Wednesday 2<sup>nd</sup> August and Friday 4<sup>th</sup> August, the AMC has five divisions: Middle Primary (Years 3–4), Upper Primary (Years 5–6), Junior (Years 7–8), Intermediate (Years 9–10) and Senior (Years 11–12). The competition will be conducted online at school during school time.

The cost to participate in the AMC is **\$8.00**, including GST.
